## MINUTES OF THE EVENTS COMMITTEE HELD AT 6.00PM ON THURSDAY 6<sup>th</sup> APRIL 2023 AT THE RINGS COMMUNITY HUB

- 1. Housekeeping: The Chairman advised those present of the emergency escape procedures. It was requested that mobile phones be switched to silent. If a call was received and had to be taken Members were politely requested to leave the room.
- **2.** Apologies for Absence Cllr Patterson.
- 3. Declarations of Interest None.
- **4. Fun Run 2023** Chris Walker and Ron Hall were in attendance to discuss Ingleby Barwick Fun Run for 2023. Stockton Borough Council's ISAG meeting to discuss the Run would be held on 16<sup>th</sup> July. Previous sponsorship money from Persimmon Homes would cover the cost of a goody bag for participants. One Stop Shop had agreed to sponsor bottled water for the event. Other potential sponsors including Roseberry Newhouse and You Fibre were being explored. Applications for the Run would open following the Local Government Elections in May and a Facebook Page would be launched around this time. Further information would he submitted to future meetings.
